Young Woman in Public Affairs 2009

Charlotte Davis, from Wellington, has been awarded the Zonta International District 16 Young Women in Public Affairs Award for 2009.



Charlotte was the unanimous choice of the independent judging panel for the District 16 (New Zealand) award.

During her years at Queen Margaret College, Wellington, Charlotte was actively involved in a wide range of extracurricular activities, including community service, arts and sport. In addition to a full academic programme and extensive cultural, sporting, and school leadership commitments, Charlotte has been active in the United Nations Youth Association of New Zealand for a number of years. She attended the Model United Nations Youth Conferences in the Netherlands and in Australia. At the beginning of 2009 Charlotte commenced study in law and engineering at Auckland University. During her university studies Charlotte intends to maintain involvement with the UN Youth Association and hopes to work with the UN, or a similar agency, in the future.

Charlotte's application has now been forwarded to Zonta International headquarters in Chicago for inclusion in the international round of judging which will be completed, and announced, by 31st July 2009.
